The Scalpel is a commercial skyscraper located on Lime Street in London City's financial district. It is known as London's sharpest Landmark building with 39 floors and 190 metres in height. The client, Convex occupy 5 floors of The Scalpel building and they commissioned a CAT B design fit out to completed across the levels in phases throughout 2019 and 2020. Profixed were awarded the supply and installation of the drylining, partitioning, glazed partitions, suspended and feature ceilings, doors, frames, joinery, tea-points and all associated works.
